SELECTS HOCKEY HISTORY

Original tryout held with the '89 age group on January 1, 2003 in Voorhees, NJ

- Selected 17 players from 68 attendees to participate in Stockholm International Youth Trophy.
- Three (3) 1st Round and one (1) 2nd Round NHL Draft picks on original roster

2004 – 2006

- Expanded to include the U12, U13, U14 and U15 age groups
- Reached the finals in EVERY tournament (21 total) over first three years
- Started Elite Camps (2004) and NAPS tournament (2005)

SELECTS HOCKEY HISTORY

2007 – 2016

- Expanded North American teams to include Midwest Selects (2007) , East Coast Selects-Q (2008), and Western Canada Selects (2011)
- Launched World Selects Invitational (WSI), supported by the launch of the Sweden, Czech, Finland, Latvia and Norway Selects (2009)
- Created the East Coast Selects Girls program (2008), subsequently expanded the Girls program to include West Coast Selects (2009), East Coast Selects-Q (2012) and Minnesota Selects (2014)
- Selects Academy at South Kent School Founded in 2011

- 34 NCAA commitments and 1 player selected in 2014 NHL Draft
- 6 current or former players on 2016 NHL Draft list
- SASKS teams qualified for USA Nationals each of the last 3 seasons
