



Rules & Regulations

This is a regular season PCAHA & BC Hockey sanctioned tournament. All games will be governed by PCAHA playing rules and PCAHA regulations with some exceptions as noted.

Round Robin Game times:

All games will have a **three (3) minute warm up**, followed by **three fifteen (15) minute** stop time periods whenever possible. One hour and fifteen minutes will be allotted for each game. If there isn't enough time for a full third, the time will be adjusted by the timekeeper to approximately half the remaining time. Should there be a tie goal result in the regulation game time, then the team will play overtime and then shootout if required.

Round Robin:

Teams will be awarded: 3 points for a regulation win

2 points for an overtime or shootout win

1 point for an overtime loss O points for a regulation loss O points for a shootout loss.

Tie Breaking for seeding and advancement final rounds:

The following tiebreakers will be used to decide final standings following round robin games:

- Head to Head Competition used only if 2 teams are tied
- 2. Regulation Wins
- Basic Goal Differential (GF GA)*
- 4. Lowest Goal Against (total ACTUAL Goals Against)
- Most Goals For
- 6. Coin Toss

Overtime:

A single five (5) minute, sudden death running time overtime period of 4 on 4 (3 skaters and a goalie) will be played to decide ties in regulation game. The first team to score a goal will win. There will be a one-minute rest between the third period and the overtime period with players remaining at their benches. Teams do not change ends during overtime. Penalties will be 2 minutes in duration.

If teams are still tied at the end of the overtime period, a shootout will commence. The team that scores the most goals out of three shooters will be declared the winner of the game. If each team has the same number of goals after the three (3) shooters, then a sudden death shootout will continue until a winner is determined. Including the initial 3 shooters, no player can shoot twice unless the entire roster has shot (excluding goalies).

^{*}Maximum Goal Differential to be awarded is FIVE GOALS.

^{*}Coaches will fill out the shootout list prior to the shootout and give it to the Referee.

General:

- No player may be rostered on more than one team. No over age players are permitted.
- Players' who are assessed a Game Misconduct penalty in the last ten minutes of a game will be suspended for a minimum one additional game.
- Players or Coaches receiving a Gross Misconduct, Match Penalty or Fighting Penalty shall be suspended from the tournament.
- · Referees are instructed to have zero tolerance for "Checking From Behind and Fighting".
- A Fighting penalty assessed at any time during the game or a Checking From Behind penalty assessed in the third period of a game will automatically include an additional next game suspension.
- There is zero tolerance for "Abuse of Officials". Offenders will be ejected from the game. The referees will be instructed to give a single warning before ejecting any coach or player from the game. Any unsportsmanlike behaviour will not be tolerated.
- Players, Team Officials or spectators who behave in an unsportsmanlike manner anywhere in the arena or on BWC property will be ejected and barred from further entry. We therefore ask that all managers and coaches instruct players and parents to understand and promote the spirit of the tournament.
- The 'Last change for home team' rule is not in effect. Due to Tournament scheduling it would not be equally fair for all teams.
- When the referee raises his/her hand no more players can change.
- Each team is allowed one (1) 30 second time out per game.
- · On-ice officials have final jurisdiction in all calls and decisions during the game
- The tournament directors, whose decisions will be final, will resolve any and all disputes.
 Mercy Rule:

If a five (5) goal differential occurs [ie: (GF - GA) > 4) at any time during the third period, the time clock will be set to running time following the subsequent face-off. Should the goal differential become less than five, the clock will revert to stop-time when the goal is scored.

Penalties during running time will be the same length as in stop time. This rule applies to all tournament games.

Playoffs:

Four (4) teams will advance to the Semi-final rounds based upon results of the round robin games, consisting of the top two (2) team from each of the two (2) pools.

The losers from each of the Semi-final games will play each other in determining 3rd & 4th place.

The winners from Semi-Final games will advance to the final championship game.

IMPORTANT - COACHES AND MANAGERS:

- After each game, teams will shake hands and line up on blue line.
- Each round robin game will have one MVP prize awarded to each team. At the conclusion of each round robin
 game each coach will choose an MVP from the opposing team. Before the game starts the selection forms will
 be provided to the team representative. No player can be chosen twice within the round robin play. Please
 make sure you return your forms to the timekeepers at the end of each game.
- Referees will hand out MVPs award to the chosen players
- At the conclusion of the round robin portion of the tournament, teams will be ranked according to their accumulated points from their round robin games.
- Players are to go on the ice for warm up only after officials are on the ice.
- Running time minor penalties will be 2 minutes in durations.

Enjoy the tournament and everything BWC and the surrounding area have to offer.






